Beginning 2014, an assessment rate for all assessment needs including the 15-8 Special Disability Fund was combined into a single assessment rate charged to NYS employers. This revenue supports both Series 2010A and 2013A Bond series. This rate was determined to be 13.8% of standard premium or equivalent. Also, the process went from a billing and collecting to a self reporting and remittance system.
